Second wife Jeanette plus all children left Weikersheim in 1839.

Some death dates come as written on the back of an old family photo, provided by Mrs Aliette Ulmann nee Pfeifer in connection with GenAmi (Association de Généalogie Juive Internationale) in Paris, France.

- (A) Aron Pfeiffer's grandfather was Marx Anschel, who became a Court Jew for the Count of Hohenlohe in Weikersheim in 1761, built a new synagogue in Weikersheim in 1768 and died there in 1780. Aron Pfeiffer's father was born as "Pfeiffer Marx" and later (around or even before 1824) changed his name to "Ezechiel Pfeiffer", adopting "Pfeiffer" as last name for his family.
- (B) Maier Kaulla (1757 1823) was also a banker, he was a son of the famous Court Jewess Madame Kaulla of Hechingen and Stuttgart.
- (C) Eduard Pfeiffer's grave inscription at Prag Cemetery:

"Ja sonst an keinem Orte wohnt die ersehnte Ruh, und nur durch diese Pforte geht man der Heimat zu"
