MARX (MORDECHAI) PFEIFFER Royal Court Jew of Wuerttemberg and citizen of Stuttgart since 1806, vicepresident and co-founder of the Wuerttembergische Hofbank in Stuttgart born 16 Aug 1786 Weikersheim, died 29 Sep 1842 Stuttgart (A) (parents = Ezechiel Pfeiffer + wife Gela Eva nee Neckarsulmer) (B) (1) married 6 Jan 1808 HENRIETTE (HENDEL) KAULLA born ?, died 20 Apr 1812 in Stuttgart in connection with birth giving (interred at Hochberg Jewish cemetery, grave 136) (father = Jakob Kaulla, in 1810 deceased banker and Imperial Court Jew in Hechingen) (2) married in 1817 DOROTHEA (TOLZ) KAULLA born ?, died 19 Jun 1822 in Stuttgart in connection with birth giving (interred at Hochberg Jewish cemetery, grave 74) (father = Wolf von Kaulla, banker and Imperial Counselor in Stuttgart, he was a nephew of the above mentioned Jakob Kaulla) (3) married 23 Jul 1823 PAULINE WITTERSHEIM born 16 Jun 1802 Metz/France, died 10 Jan 1867 Stuttgart (parents = Nathanael Wittersheim, Chief Rabbi in Metz/France + his second wife Esther nee Mayer Marx Beer, who died 26 Jun 1826 - she was interred at the Jewish cemetery of Hochberg near Stuttgart, grave 141) CHILDREN (probably all born in Stuttgart) first wife = 01, second wife = 02-05, third wife = 06-13 : (C) 13 Apr 1812 - 29 Dec 1858 (died Vienna, Austria) (01) HENRIETTE married 30 Oct 1832 Court jeweller Josef David Loeb Biedermann in Vienna (31 Dec 1809 - 3 Mar 1867) (list of children available) daughter Emilie married Joseph (see child 05) (02) JULIE 29 Dec 1818 - ? (married 1840 in Karlsruhe merchant Friedrich Kusel of Karlsruhe) (03) LOUISE 26 Jan 1820 - ? married 5 Dec 1837 Salomon Friedrich Kaulla, born 1807 (owner of Oberdischingen dominion) (04) HELENA 14 Jan 1821 - 24 Feb 1900 (buried Père-Lachaise) mrd. 1843 bookdealer Georges Kugelmann in Paris (ca 1809 - 19 Sep 1882, buried at Père Lachaise)

(05)	JOSEPH MAX		23 May 1822 - 19 Mar 1897 (died Vienna, Austria as Josef Max Ritter von Pfeiffer) he had a wholesale business in Vienna he married (1) 1850 Franziska von Koenigswarter (she was the daughter of a banker in Vienna) (05 Dec 1830 Vienna - 22 Feb 1852 Vienna) he married (2) 1 Jul 1855 in Ulm Emilie Biedermann (10 Feb 1836 Vienna - 28 Sep 1912 Vienna) (list of children available)
			Emilie was daughter of Henriette (see child 01)

(07)	CLARISSE	(D)	04 May 1826 - 28 Mar 1889 (died in Stuttgart) (married 1849 Dr med Hermann Kaulla in Strassburg, he must have died before 1860), their son was the prominent banker Alfred von Kaulla in Stuttgart (8 Aug 1852 Strassburg - 14 Jan 1924 Stuttgart)
(08)	ESTHER		23 Aug 1827 - ? (married 1852 Martin Walkerhauser, with whom she emigrated to Antwerpen)

(13)	GOTTHILF EDUARD (called Eduard)	(D)	24 Nov 1835 - 13 May 1921 (died in Stuttgart) married 12 Sep 1872 in Baden-Baden Julie nee Kann (daughter of Eduard Kann and his wife Stephanie nee Baer of Frankfurt/Main, widow of Paris banker Louis Ferdinand Victor Benary, who died 1869 in Paris) born 9 Sep 1843 Frankfurt/Main died 5 Feb 1926 Stuttgart (couple had no children)
			Dr Eduard Pfeifer was president and co-founder of the Wuerttembergische Vereinsbank in Stuttgart since 1904 and president of the "Society for the Welfare of the Working Class" and supported important housing projects for workers, in 1909 he became a citizen of honour of Stuttgart.

(A) Marx Pfeiffer's family sheet in Stuttgart shows his birth date as 25 Jul 1787, Weikersheim birth records show his birth date as 16 Aug 1786.

(B) Marx Pfeiffer's grandfather was Marx Anschel, who became a Court Jew for the Count of Hohenlohe in Weikersheim in 1761, built a new synagogue in Weikersheim in 1768 and died there in 1780. Marx Pfeiffer's father was born as "Pfeiffer Marx" and later (around 1824 or even before) changed his name to "Ezechiel Pfeiffer", adopting "Pfeiffer" as last name for his family.

(C) Josef David Loeb Biedermann was the son of Michael Lazarus Biedermann, who was born in Pressburg (Hungary) in 1769 and went to Vienna (Austria) as a young boy. He started as a seal engraver, later became a jeweller and finally a successful whole sale merchant (first with wool, later also with agricultural goods). He died in Vienna in 1843.

(D) Eduard Pfeiffer and his wife are buried at the christian part of the Prag cemetery in Stuttgart, and so are his sister Clarisse Kaulla and her son Alfred von Kaulla.
