SIEGFRIED WIESENGRUND

wine merchant in Noerdlingen since 1914
born 28 Dec 1882 Dettelbach, died ? (moved to Hochheim/Main in 1936)
parents = Adolph Wiesengrund + wife Ida nee Thalheimer

married (1) 6 Oct 1912 in New York (couple got divorced around 1934 ?)

JULIE HEYMANN

born 6 Jan 1885 Noerdlingen, died ? (emigrated to New York in 1934)
parents = coal dealer David Heymann + wife Johanna nee Heumann

married (2)

GERTRUD COHEN

born 30 Apr 1895 Hochheim / Main

CHILDREN (all born in Noerdlingen):

- (01) **IRENE** 25 Jul 1914 - 13 Oct 1914
- (02) **ADOLF** 16 Aug 1915 - 15 Dec 1995
died in Delray Beach, Palm Beach, Florida USA
emigrated to the USA in 1934, lived in
New York and changed name to Al Steiner
married
Edith nee Steiner
09 Dec 1916 - 16 Jul 1997
she also died in Delray Beach, Florida
- (03) **GERTRUD** 12 Oct 1917 - ? moved to Wesseling in 1934,
emigrated to the USA in 1934 together with Adolf

Siegfried Wiesengrund probably was related to the philosopher **Theodor Ludwig W Adorno** (1903-1969), "W" standing for Wiesengrund. His father **Oscar Alexander Wiesengrund** (wholesale wine trader in Frankfurt/Main, married to **Maria Cavelli della Plana**) had converted to Lutheran faith.

A brother of Siegfried Wiesengrund was **Manfred Wiesengrund**, pharmacist in Munich, born 10 Aug 1879 in Dettelbach, founded a pharmacy in Mount Carmel, Israel and returned to Munich after WW II, where he died on 24 Aug 1863. He married (1) on 5 Dec 1910 in Ansbach **Paula nee Weil**, born 29 Apr 1890 in Ansbach as daughter of Jakob Weil + Luise nee Laemle. He married (2) on 19 Oct 1926 in Munich **Mina nee Schweisheimer**, born 11 Jan 1901 in Noerdlingen as daughter of Moritz + Mathilde Schweisheimer, who died 16 Feb 1978 in Munich. Child out of first marriage = **Adolf** (17 Jan 1912 - 23 Dec 1912)

Children of **Salomon Wiesengrund** (who died 1921 in Nuernberg):

Elsa Wiesengrund (born 12 Nov 1878 in Dettelbach) was deported in 1942 from Nuernberg to Izbica and died there (exact date unknown).

Sophie Wiesengrund (born 3 Jan 1893 in Dettelbach) was deported in 1940 from Nuernberg to Cholm near Lublin and died there 3 Dec 1940 in a lunatic asylum.

Elsa's and Sophie were cousins of Siegfried Wiesengrund,
