ABAHAM MANNHEIMER (A)

teacher in Harburg 1890-1898, teacher in Dettelbach 1898-1937 (B)
born 16 Jan 1867 Okriftel near Hattersheim, died 13 Feb 1943 Theresienstadt
parents = teacher NN Mannheimer + wife NN

married before 1897 (where ?)

BERTHA SONN

born 24 Jan 1866 Moenchsdeggingen, died 25 Apr 1927 Dettelbach
she died the day after Pessach and was buried in Roedelsee
parents = hazzan Nathan Sonn + wife Sara nee Sternberger (C)

CHILDREN (01+02 born in Harburg, 03-06 born in Dettelbach):

(01) SARA	30 Jan 1897 - ca 1942 (died in Izbica)
(02) SIMON	02 Mar 1898 - ?
(03) FRIEDA	13 Nov 1899 - ca 1942 (died in Izbica)
(04) IDA first twin	14 Oct 1901 - ca 1942 (died in Izbica)
(05) LEA second twin	14 Oct 1901 - ca 1942 (died in Izbica)
(06) EDDA (born Thea)	09 Aug 1903 - 02 May 2001 (died in Bronx NY) married Frank Wogelt 04 Jul 1889 - April 1975 (died in New York) parents = ? couple lived in New York by 1945

(A) Abraham Mannheimer had a brother David Mannheimer (31 Jul 1870 - 10 Sep 1942) who lived in Hoechst-am-Main and was deported to Theresienstadt where he died. His wife had died on 24 Jul 1929 in Hoechst.

(B) In Dettelbach Abraham Mannheimer became successor of teacher Jakob Kahn ca 1817 - 9 Aug 1906), who was born in Hoechberg near Wuerzburg and first had served as teacher in Mainbernheim, since 1858 until 1898 in Dettelbach. His wife had died a few years before 1906.

(C) Nathan Sonn was a son-in-law and successor of longtime hazzan Hirz Sternberger in Moenchsdeggingen until this Jewish community came to its end around 1875. It's so far unknown where Nathan Sonn + family moved after 1875.
