BERNHARD HENRY GOTTHELF (born as Baruch Hirsch) (A) shochet, hazzan, emigrated to North America around 1840 served as (not ordained) Rabbi in Philadelphia (Pennsylvania), Louisville (Kentucky) + Vicksburg (Mississippi) born 5 Feb 1816 Kleinerdlingen (Bavaria), died 7 Sep 1878 Vicksburg MS parents = shochet Joseph Marx Gotthelf + wife Gietel nee Murr (B)

married ca 1839 (in Binswangen/Bavaria ?)

## SOPHIA LANDAUER

born 25 Feb 1822 Binswangen (Bavaria), died 12 Apr 1917 Vicksburg MS parents = butcher Jakob Hirsch Landauer + wife Kela/Karoline nee Steinhart

couple by 1880 had one child and lived with Emma's mother Sophia, in 1930 Emma still lived in Vicksburg MS

(A) "B H" Gotthelf (even his grave inscription shows his given names only by initials) must have emigrated to North America around 1840 and lived in Maryland (Baltimore?), before in 1847 he became minister (cantor + preacher) of Reform Congregation Keneseth Israel in Philadelphia (Pennsylvania). In 1848 he was elected cantor and shochet for Adath Israel Congregation in Louisville (Kentucky), but in fact acted as (non ordained) Rabbi. When in 1854 a secular school was founded there, he became the Hebrew teacher. During Civil War (in 1862) he was appointed chaplain for the hospital ministery as one of three chaplains for Jewish soldiers of the Union Army. After Civil War Rabbi Gotthelf in 1866 was offered the pulpit of Congregation Anshe Chesed (= "men

- of kindness") in Vicksburg (Mississippi). In 1878 B H Gotthelf died from yellow fever during a terrible epidemic, while still ministering the Jewish congregation of Vicksburg. About 1/3 of this congregation died in these days. Rabbi Gotthelf was buried at Anshe Chesed Cemetery. His grave monument still exists, next to his wife + son Morris.
- (B) Joseph Marx Gotthelf (1762-1844) was a hazzan + shochet in Kleinerdlingen since 1797 (his father Marx Loew was in the same position until he died in 1791). Around 1795 he married Gietel (1780-1847). So far this couple had six known children born between 1805 and 1825, plus some more children born before 1805 (five of them born before 1801). Besides Bernard Henry (born Baruch Hirsch) at least two more of these children then emigrated to North America = Meyer + Leopold (born Lazarus) (see own family sheets)
- (C) Liquor brands were "Kentucky Oaks" + "Magnolia" + "Old Thoroughbred Rye". Nathan F Block's brother Joseph Block (born 11 Sep 1849) married Nellie Frank.
