(A) Martin Cramer was born 08 Aug 1880 in Speyer and got married on 04 Nov 1911 in Augsburg to Klara Berberich, born 26 Aug 1886 in Augsburg as daughter of Isak Berberich (died 06 Mar 1916 in Augsburg) + wife Betty nee Gerstle (died 25 Mar 1935 in Augsburg). Martin and Klara Cramer were deported from Augsburg in 1942 by Nazi authorities and died in Piaski as victims of Shoah. Same fate occurred to their son Erwin Cramer (born 01 Aug 1921 in Augsburg).
