HEINRICH KRONHEIMER (born Hajum) (Note A)

in Schopfloch, moved to Munich after 1855

born 19 Jan 1819 Schopfloch, died 1899 in Munich

parents = Moses Hajum Kronheimer + first wife Margolis nee Freundlich

married 25 Nov 1844 (previous date in Version 6 incorrect)

SOFIE (Sprinz) **BERNHEIMER**

born 5 Apr 1823 Schopfloch, died 10 Mar 1858 Schopfloch

parents = Moses Samuel Bernheimer + Gale (Karoline)Hamburger (Note B)

CHILDREN (born in Schopfloch):

(01)**MAX** (born MEIER) born 22 Aug 1845; migrated to Melbourne Australia, 1860; died 24 Sep 1893 (fell overboard and drowned, South Australia); married Adele Segalla (born 1857, died 30 Mar 1933, Melbourne)

CHILDREN

(a)Aimee (born 12 July 1891, Melbourne) Never married, changed her surname to **KEYNES**; died 16 Oct 1972, Melbourne.

(b) Edgar born 1893, Melbourne died in infancy, prior to death of father.

(02) **KLARA** 24 Jun 1847 - 04 Aug 1933 (Schaftlach near Munich) buried in Oettingen; married 16 Nov 1869 in Oettingen **Simon Englaender** from Hainsfarth, merchant in Oettingen 31 Mar 1837 - 18 Feb 1917 (died in Oettingen) parents = David Loew Engländer + wife Kela/Karoline nee Engländer (see own family sheet)

(03) **ROSALIE** 30 Nov 1848 – 30 June 1870 (in Schopfloch)

- (04) **WOOLF** (born Wolf) born 21 January 1851, migrated to Melbourne, died after several months illness at the home of his uncle Joseph Kronheimer on 19 May 1870.
- (05) **ELIAS** 17 Aug 1853 17 Jul 1936 (died in Munich, recorded as a victim of the Shoah); lived in Munich after 1900

married 15 Apr 1885 Lina Saemann from Sugenheim

27 Feb 1864 - 16 Sep 1940 (died in Munich)

parents = Joseph Saemann + wife Getta (nee Rosenbaum)

no children known

(06) **SAMUEL** 11 Jul 1855 - 11 Jun 1937 (died in Munich); pencil manufacturer in Munich; married 24 Aug 1881 **Rosa Metzger** from Fürth 12 Jul 1859 - 02 Sep 1934 (died in Munich) parents = Sigmund Metzger and Johanna (nee Reinemann) The couple had 5 children =

(a) Sofie Kronheimer

06 Jun 1882 - 26 Nov 1942 (died in Theresienstadt)

married 7 Jan 1904 in Munich **Siegfried Weil** from Munich, a merchant in Munich, 02 Jun 1874 - 06 Nov 1943 (died in Theresienstadt)

parents = Sigmund Weil + Leonora nee Raff

(b) Johanna (Hansi) Kronheimer

20 Apr 1883 - 20 Feb 1941 (died in Munich)

married 5 Sep 1905 in Munich **Nathan Norbert Rosenthal** from Munich; born 01 Mar 1874; died 25 Jun 1944 (in Theresienstadt); after 1922 was the sole owner of famous antiquarian bookshop "Ludwig Rosenthal" in Munich, founded by his father in 1859.

parents = Ludwig Rosenthal + Minna nee Mueller

(c) Max Wilhelm Kronheimer

16 Sep 1886 - ?. Married Nelly (nee Basch)

The couple had one child:

(i) **Hedwig** (born 1910 -- ?)

(d) Wilhelm Kronheimer (Dr jur)

01 May 1888 - 1943 (died in Auschwitz)

lawyer, employed by German Railway system

moved from Mannheim to Munich in 1933

married (1) before 1923 Elsa Fanny Metzger from Frankfurt/Main

03 Jun 1898 -1985 (England); couple were divorced in 1931

The couple had two children (emigrated in 1936 to Switzerland)

- (i) Anita born 23 Aug 1923 Berlin
- (ii) Erwin born 11 Feb 1928 Munich

married (2) 23 Aug 1939 in Munich

Hermine Neuburger from Munich

06 Jan 1890 - 27 Jan 1943 (died in Auschwitz)

parents = Gustav Neuburger + wife Pauline (nee Bamberger)

(e) Hedwig Dina Kronheimer

26 Jan 1890 -1959

Married Ernst Kehrmann from ?; ? - ?

Notes

- (A) For details of family structure see **Kronheimer family chart**.(But see Note C.)
- (B) **Moses Samuel Bernheimer** was born c. 1790 in Jochsberg and settled in Schopfloch around 1822 as farmer + cattle dealer. He died on 15 Apr 1869 in Schopfloch (grave 0324). His wife **Gale Bernheimer** had died on 4 Apr 1865 in Schopfloch (grave 0372); see Hamburger Family tree.

Additional notes:

- (C) Heinrich's younger brother Joseph migrated to Melbourne, Australia and established a highly successful business in which first his nephew Max became a partner and a generation later his great-nephew Jacob Engländer, son of Simon Engländer and Klara (nee Kronheimer) joined the business. According to relatives in Melbourne, Joseph was not married.
- (D) Another younger brother Elias (Julius) married Fanny (Franziska) Freundlich. The original Harburg list notes that Fanny was the daughter of Joseph and Lea Freundlich. What was not noted was that Joseph was one of two sons of Meier Isaak and Voegele Freundlich, who were the parents of Margolis Kronheimer, the mother of Heinrich, Elias (Julius) and three others. In other words, Elias (Julius) and Fanny were first cousins.
- (E) Elias (Julius) and Fanny, as noted on the original Harburg list had two children and several grandchildren. One grandchild, Max Wildberg (1899-1960) married Irma Scherbel (1897-1990), the couple migrated to Melbourne Australia before World War II. Their two children Kurt and Anneliese (Ann) each married in Germany, both also migrated to Melbourne and are still living (May 2014). There are four generations of the Wildberg family living in Melbourne, with Kurt and Rae Wildberg's great-grand-daughter Ruby Rose Samuels born on 15 Aug 2013.
- (F) The author of these revisions, Dr Paul Gardner, is a great-grandson of Simon and Klara Engländer (nee Kronheimer). Their daughter Rosalie married Albert Gärtner; the couple had three sons, one of whom, Lothar, was Paul's father. Lothar and his wife Irma (nee Badrian) migrated to Australia in 1938 and Albert and Rosalie followed a year later. Paul and his wife, Dr Helen Gardner, both born in Melbourne, are the parents of four children and they have eleven grandchildren.

Although not in surname, the Kronheimer family lives on in Australia.
