teacher in Hainsfarth for Jewish elementary school 1863 - 1909 also served as shochet + hazzan born 03 Nov 1835 Poppenlauer, died 05 Apr 1910 Oettingen (A) grave 134 parents = Abraham Friedmann + wife Jochevet nee Blumgart

married (1) 25 Aug 1865 in Hainsfarth (Rabbi = David Weisskopf)

BABETTE HOLLERBAUM

born 24 Jul 1844 Diespeck, died 28 May 1883 Hainsfarth (grave 169) (B) parents = Benjamin Hollerbaum + wife Theres

married (2) 31 Oct 1883 in Kleinerdlingen (Rabbi = Marx Michael Kohn)

THERESE HEUMANN

born 23 Mar 1844 Hainsfarth, died ? parents = Heium Heumann + wife Veile nee Neumetzger

Therese in 1910 moved to Schwanfeld near Schweinfurt where her son Siegbert Friedmann served as teacher + hazzan and Therese probably died there.

JOSEPHINE (PEPPI) OPPENHEIMER from Dettensee 15 Dec 1868 - 17 Sep 1924 (died in Munich as noted at official Ingolstadt Friedmann family card, but was buried in Ingolstadt) parents = Simon Oppenheimer (1822-1894) + wife Wilhelmine (Mina) nee Hirschfelder (1835-1911) couple had a daughter (born in Ingolstadt) = Paula Friedmann 23 Nov 1900 - 29 Dec 1985 (died in Miami, Florida) married 30 Jul 1923 in Ansbach Karl Kissinger from Ermershausen (uncle of US politician Henry Kissinger) training as assistant teacher at ILBA in Wuerzburg, soldier since 1916 for Bavarian Army Infantry during World War I, since 1923 shoe store partner with father-in-law Arno Friedmann in Ingolstadt

		ESTHER SCHWAB from Frankfurt-am-Main 05 Dec 1880 - 26 Oct 1939 (died in Gateshead) parents = Hermann Hirsch Schwab + wife Mathilde
		couple had two children:

(06) SIEGBERT		20 Dec 1880 - ca 1943 (died in Minsk) hazzan + teacher + shochet in Schwanfeld, after 1925 in Mainstockheim, moved with wife to Ingolstadt in 1933, since 1935 lived in Munich married 03 Jan 1911 in Wuerzburg IDA KISSINGER from Ermershausen (aunt of US politician Henry Kissinger) 15 Sep 1888 - ca 1943 (died in Izbica) parents = David Kissinger + wife Karoline (Lina) nee Zeilberger
		Siegbert + Ida became victims of Shoah

		Bella + Julius emigrated to London, England in 1938, but moved to the USA in 1940

- (A) Death note = STAA (BA Noerdlingen, Abgabe 1951, Nr 3219), Marcus Friedmann had moved from Hainsfarth to Oettingen in 1909
- (B) Babette's grave inscription: "So frueh in Deines Lebens Mai bist Edle Du geschieden, nahe Gottes Vaterhand schlummere nun in Frieden"
- (C) Arno Friedmann since ca 1919 owned house 10 Ludwig Strasse in Ingolstadt where he ran his shoe store and also lived with his family at second upper level with stucco ceilings and streetside verandas. As a member of the local historical society Arno Friedmann in 1900 + 1902 wrote two booklets on the history of Jews in Ingolstadt and Monheim and in 1929 another one on various subjects of regional Jewish history (title = "Bilder aus meiner Heimatgeschichte"). Arno Friedmann's gravestone still exists at Jewish Cemetery Ingolstadt.
- (D) Simon Oppenheimer died 28 Jun 1894 in Dettensee, his wife Wilhelmine died 25 Feb 1911 in Ingolstadt (her gravestone still exists)
- (E) Isidor's marriage file see State Archives Augsburg, BA Noerdlingen, Ansaessigmachungs- und Verehelichungsakten, AuVA 1873-1915 (59/1902)
- (F) Further children were Lilly (became victim of Shoah) + Manfred (born 22 Jul 1922) emigrated to Melbourne, Australia where he died in 1990.
