first and last District Rabbi of Schopfloch district 1841 - 1872 born 12 Apr 1807 Schopfloch, died 19 May 1872 Schopfloch parents = grave digger Moses Jacob Ehrlich (1774 - 1849) + wife Klaerchen nee Bechhoefer (1775 - 1855)

married 20 Jul 1842

born 12 Aug 1817 Schopfloch, died 1892 Fuerth parents = Seckel Loeb Neustaedtel (1787 - 1855) + first wife Jeanette (Schenla) nee Goldscheider (1784 - 1841) (B)

(A) Nathan Ehrlich succeeded Rabbi Hirsch Gabriel Weil (27 Feb 1764 - 27 Apr 1839) who had served as local Rabbi in Schopfloch (1799 - 1839) and had married before 1792 Hinla from Hamburg (born 24 May 1771. Parts of this information comes from "Biographisches Handbuch der Rabbiner" by Michael Brocke + Julius Carlebach.

Hirsch Gabriel's predecessor was Baer Abraham, serving as local Rabbi in Schopfloch from 1791 until 29 May 1799 when he died. His descendants adopted family name **DICK** around 1813.

In connection with the division of the Ansbach District Rabbinate in 1841, Schopfloch became a District Rabbinate of its own, serving Schopfloch + Feuchtwangen + Wittelshofen. Nathan Ehrlich had studied at the University of Wuerzburg and got his talmudic training at the Jeshiwa of Rabbi Abraham Bing.

(B) Nathan Ehrlich's grandmother must have been Rosalie Ehrlich (24 Aug 1747 - after 1816) in Schopfloch, whose husband had died before 1816. Her daughter Recha Ehrlich (12 Mar 1785 - 07 Sep 1852) married around 1816 Isaac Hirsch Jacob Feuchtwanger (4 Feb 1780 - 23 May 1854), teacher in Schopfloch.
