banker in Stuttgart, partner of Pflaum & Loewenstein Bank at Koenig Strasse 31 A (A) born 26 Oct 1852 Oedheim, died 5 Aug 1923 Stuttgart parents = Jakob Loewenstein + wife Dina nee Stern from Oedheim (B) (G)

married 2 Dec 1886 in Stuttgart

EMILIE WORMSER

born 26 May 1863 Aldingen near Stuttgart, died 16 May 1924 Stuttgart parents = Heumann Wormser (19 Feb 1819 Aldingen - 12 May 1896 Stuttgart) + wife Jette nee Rau (11 Feb 1829 Pflaumloch - 12 Jul 1906 Freudenstadt)

(03) ELSE	(E)	23 Nov 1893 - 14 Jul 1930 (died in Stuttgart) married 22 Oct 1919 in Stuttgart Max Dreifus from Stuttgart 18 Feb 1891 - 08 Jun 1987 (emigrated to the USA and died in Columbus, Franklin County, Ohio) parents ? = David Dreifus + wife Henriette n Levi
		couple had two children by 1923 (Max ? + Helga)
	(F)	after his first wife had died, Max Dreifus remarried in 1946 Deborah "Doris" Jacobson from Glasgow, Scotland 29 Jul 1898 - 03 Jan 2004 (died in Columbus, Ohio) parents = Meyer Jacobson + wife Nora nee Bloom
(04) MAX		10 Apr 1896 - 20 May 1917 (died in France in combat action during World War I, buried at Jewish part of Prag cemetery in Stuttgart)

(A) Loewenstein's partner was David Pflaum (15 May 1851 - 9 May 1886), son of master clothmaker Marx Pflaum in Pflaumloch + wife Rebekka Simon.

David Pflaum was not married, his home was at Gaisburg Strasse 8. He lived there with the widow Friederike Pflaum. The bank was founded around 1880. After David Pflaum had died, Naphtali Loewenstein got associated (company "Gebrueder Loewenstein Bank" in Stuttgart) with his brother Liebmann Loewenstein, who married Elise Loewengart from Hechingen in August 1890.

(B) Jakob Loewenstein was born in Bonfeld on 26 Dec 1819 and started his educational training at first as assistant of teacher David Mainhardt in Michelbach an der Luecke and then became a student at the Teacher Seminar in Esslingen 1835-1838. He then served as a teacher and hazzan in various places like Gerabronn (1839-1841), Korb (1841-1844), Oedheim (1847-1852), Hohebach (6 Apr 1853-16 Dec 1856). From 1856 until 1862 he was a teacher and hazzan in Oberdorf. From 1862 until 1882 he finally served as a teacher in Sontheim and Heilbronn. He died in Heilbronn in 1884. His wife Dina (1826-1884 ?), whom he had married in Oedheim on 30 Apr 1850, also died in Heilbronn.

Couple had a son Oskar Loewenstein, and also another son Jerucham Leopold, who was born on 19 Feb 1850 in Oedheim = two months before they got married

(C) Arthur Loewenstein was the author of a book on Jewish banking business in Wuerttemberg (Geschichte des Wuerttembergischen Kreditbankwesens, printed in 1912), probably his doctoral thesis in connection with his studies at Heidelberg University. Around 1921 he moved to Berlin together with his wife + first born son, family later emigrated to the USA with their two sons Mark Oliver (born 16 Apr 1920 in Stuttgart, died 15 Dec 1997 in Larchmont, Westchester County, New York) and was married since 24 Mar 1957 in Riverdale NY USA - there were two children out of this marriage) and Ernest Albert (born 17 Jul 1926 in Berlin-Charlottenburg, died 18 Mar 1998 in Brookline, Massachusetts and was married since 4 Aug 1953 in Amsterdam, Netherlands his wife was still living around 2001). Mark Oliver and Ernest Albert both adopted surname "Lynton".

(D) Lizzie's parents are an assumption so far. Friedrich L Kiefe (7 Dec 1866 - 22 Nov 1941) was married to Anna nee Kunreuther (21 May 1870 - 4 Jan 1939).
He was a partner of Kiefe & Co banking business in Stuttgart.

(E) Max Dreifus was a manufacturer of men's wear in Stuttgart (Dreifus & Lehmann Company) This company was founded by his father ? David Dreifus + partner Josef Lehmann. Partners of Max Dreifus were D Dreifus (14 Jul 1858 - 17 Aug 1937) and Albert Levi (24 Jan 1878 - 1 Apr 1920).

Max Dreifus' daughter Helga was born 3 Feb 1925 in Stuttgart, she died in 1990 in the USA and was married since 19 May 1946 to Newman H Braun.

(G) Jakob Loewenstein's parents were Loew Lippmann Loewenstein (teacher in Steinbach near Schwaebisch Hall, lived from 1769 until 29 Jan 1850, buried at Steinbach cemetery) and his wife Esther. She was a daughter of Abraham Moyses Simon Rimon + wife Kela in Oettingen. Her brother was the teacher Simon Rimon (or Riemann) in Oettingen (28 Oct 1781 - 19 Aug 1864). Dina nee Stern's parents were Hirsch Stern in Oedheim and his wife Zerline nee Rosenstein.
