last name "Weinberger" was only adopted in 1813

## **SAMUEL WEINBERGER**

day worker in Steinhart

born ca 1794 Steinhart, died 12 May 1869 Steinhart

parents = Israel Loew Weinberger + first wife Esther (A)

married 12 Jul 1835 in Steinhart

## **BESLE EMANUEL**

born ca 1797 Steinhart, died 16 Feb 1878 Wuerzburg

buried at Hochberg Jewish Cemetery near Wuerzburg

parents = Abraham Emanuel + wife Feile

CHILDREN (all born in Steinhart):

- (01) **BERTHA WEINBERGER** 12 Sep 1836 - 04 Jun 1911 Wuerzburg  
(born Breindel) married before 1864  
**SALOMON SELIGSBERGER** from Fuchsstadt  
since 1864 cloth + antiques trader in Wuerzburg  
30 May 1831 - 20 Jun 1888 Wuerzburg (suicide)  
parents = Lekisch Seligsberger + wife Kindel  
  
as a widow Bertha Seligsberger continued with  
the antiques trading business together with her  
children **Ernestine** 1864-1939 + **Sigmund** 1875-1943  
(Sigmund died in Sobibor as Shoah victim)
- (02) **NN** (stillborn girl) 02 Jul 1838
- (03) **ENSLE WEINBERGER** 22 Jul 1839 - ca 1904 New York  
(called Israel) died as Isaac S Emanuel Weinberger

(A) Israel Loew Weinberger (ca 1752 - 9 Mar 1826) settled in Steinhart around 1778 as a cattle dealer and married Esther (who died before November 1816). He then married on 27 Nov 1816 Bunle Bergmann (born in Altenmuhr), widow of Wolf Bergmann in Heidenheim / Franconia. Esther's grave is unknown, and Bunle obviously left Steinhart after her husband Israel Loew had died.

(B) Besle Emanuel had given birth to 5 illegitimate children between 1821 and 1832 prior to marriage - father probably was Samuel Israel Weinberger:

- (a) **MOSES EMANUEL** 15 Jun 1821 - ?
- (b) **ESTHER EMANUEL** 14 Apr 1825 - 1899 Chicago USA  
married with A Neumann from Bavaria ?
- (c) **SARA EMANUEL** 26 Aug 1827 - 1895 Horton, Kansas USA  
(called Sophia Ann)

- (d) **TREINLE EMANUEL** 23 Dec 1829 - 26 Sep 1899 Quincy, Illinois USA  
(called Theres) married on 01 Jan 1853 in New York
- (B) **SIMON BERGER** from Fuchsstadt  
(born as Simon Seligsberger)  
real estate businessman in Quincy  
28 Dec 1828 - 1910 Quincy, Illinois USA  
parents = Lekisch Seligsberger + wife Kindel  
Simon + Theres had lived in Quincy since 1875
- (e) **MEILE EMANUEL** 13 May 1832 - 23 Nov 1910 New York  
(called Amelia) emigrated to USA around 1848  
married 1851  
**SIMON HIRSCH HERRMANN** from Steinhart  
07 Oct 1828 - 01 May 1903 New York  
parents = Samuel Isaac Herrmann +  
2<sup>nd</sup> wife Krendele nee Oberdorfer

(B) Simon Berger was a brother of Salomon Seligsberger who had founded an antiques trading business in Wuerzburg in 1864 and who had married Bertha Weinberger = sister of Simon's wife Theres.
